**ANNUAL QUALITY ASSURANCE REPORT (AQAR)**  
**for the academic year 2014-15 to be submitted to NAAC**

**1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution:**

The main objective of the institution is to provide higher education to the poor rural students in and around Cheyyar, to develop their all round personality and to provide guidance and support in making them employable. Its goal is to cherish the quality of its products and to raise their standard of living.

- New courses that could fetch job opportunities have been introduced at nominal cost.
- Buses have been plied to all the arterial routes to facilitate transportation at nominal fare.
- Government scholarships have been arranged for the students who are financially weak.
- The Management offers scholarship to the poor and meritorious students to the tune of Sixty Thousand rupees every year from the endowment of Abboy Trust.
- Concession in tuition fees is given to the students who are financially weak.
- Best performers in academic activities are promptly rewarded.
- Best performers in sports have been supplied the required training and essential nutrition.
- Maintains a learner-centric environment.
- The atmosphere is conducive to learning and to pursue higher studies.
- Hostel facilities for both the boys and girls at affordable charges.
- Add-on courses while pursuing Regular Degree Courses.
- Free English and Tamil typewriting classes to students.

**2. New academic Programmes initiated (UG AND PG):**

- M.Phil (English) and M.Phil (Mathematics) courses have been started. The English and Mathematics Departments have been upgraded as Research Departments.
- The Department of Biochemistry has sought for fresh affiliation to PhD Biochemistry.

**3. Innovations in Curricular Designed Transaction:**

The University has introduced (CBCS) Choice Based Credit System. It includes (CIA) Continuous Internal Assessment. The Internal Assessment is done based on the tests the students take, the assignments they submit and the papers they present. The attendance of the students is also taken into account for the award of Continuous Internal Assessment.

#### **4. Inter-disciplinary programmes started:**

The curriculum has been developed in such a way that the students can study two papers at the third and fourth semesters (one paper each semester) which belong to other disciplines. This inter-disciplinary programme is termed as Non-Major Elective. Additionally, the students are facilitated to Study Skill Based Papers based on the nature of their major subjects.

#### **5. Examination Reforms Implemented:**

The curriculum follows Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) which includes Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA). The minimum score for a pass in Theory paper is 30 out of 75 for UG Courses and 38 out of 75 for PG Courses. There is no passing minimum for the Continuous Internal Assessment which is for 25 marks. The students have to secure 40 percent (totaling internal and external marks) to get a pass. The university follows single valuation for both the UG and the PG courses. The students can apply for revaluation of answer scripts if they fail in one paper. They are permitted to apply for revaluation of two answer scripts if they failed in two papers of the last semester. There is a provision for Instant Supplementary Exam if the students have one arrear paper that belongs to any semester.

**25. Computerization of administration and the process and examinations results, issue of certificates.**

All aspects of administration of the college and its constituent Departments have been computerized. In addition to the publication of the results in its website, the university sends results through results sheets to the college. Our institution has an institutional website (**iac-cheyyar.com**).
