- 1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution:
 - The main objective of the institution is to provide higher education to the poor rural students in and around Cheyyar, to develop their all round personality and to provide guidance and support in making them employable. Its goal is to cherish the quality of its products and to raise their standard of living.

2. New academic Programmes initiated (UG AND PG):

PhD Programme in Biochemistry got affiliated.

3. Innovations in Curricular Designed Transaction:

The University has introduced (CBCS) Choice Based Credit System. It includes (CIA) Continuous Internal Assessment. The Internal Assessment is done based on the tests the students take, the assignments they submit and the papers they present. The attendance of the students is also taken into account for the award of Continuous Internal Assessment.

4. Inter-disciplinary programmes started:

The curriculum has been developed in such a way that the students can study two papers at the third and fourth semesters (one paper each semester) which belong to other disciplines. This inter-disciplinary programme is termed as Non-Major Elective. Additionally, the students are facilitated to Study Skill Based Papers related to their major subjects.

5. Examination Reforms Implemented:

The curriculum follows Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) which includes Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA). The minimum score for a pass in Theory paper is 30 out of 75 for UG Courses and 38 out of 75 for PG Courses. There is no passing minimum for the (CIA) Continuous Internal Assessment which is for 25 marks. The students have to secure 40 percent (totaling internal and external marks) to get a pass. The university follows single valuation for both the UG and the PG courses. The students can apply for revaluation of answer scripts if they fail in one paper. They are permitted to apply for revaluation of two answer scripts if they fail in two papers of the last semester. There is a provision for Instant Supplementary Exam if the students have one arrear paper that belongs to any semester.

Our College has two NSS Units. Mr. S. Senthil, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Mathematics and Mr. K.Srinivasan, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Business Administration are the Programme Officers. There are Two Hundred Volunteers in both the units.

On 15.06.2016, the NSS of Indo-American College, Cheyyar organized a blood donation camp in association with Chengalpet Medical College. Students and staff from various departments donated 67 units of blood.

25. Computerization of administration and the process and examinations results, issue of certificates.

All aspects of administration of the college and its constituent Departments have been computerized. In addition to the publication of the results in its website, the university sends results through results sheets to the college. Our institution has an institutional website (iaccheyyar.com).

Collection of fees and the maintenance of income and expenditure are done with the help of Office Automation software. Issue of Printed Transfer Certificates is done with the help of the database.

26. Increase in the infrastructural facilities:

New equipments have been purchased for the Chemistry Laboratory. An amount of Rs.2, 38,396 has been spent exclusively to purchase laboratory equipments.

The infrastructure of other laboratories has been developed by the addition of new equipments. The classrooms have been furnished with adequate furniture. Classrooms are adequate to run the current courses. New buses have been purchased to meet the increased number of students from remote areas.

27. Technology up gradation :

New sets of UPSs have been installed to support/supply power to the newly bought computer systems. Audio-visual aids to assist teaching-learning have been purchased.

28. Computer and Internet access and Training to teachers and students:

All the laboratories of the departments have been facilitated with 24 hours Internet connection. Two Internet Centers one at the library for the access of staff and students and another for the Research Scholars have been maintained with internet connection. Staff and students who do not have exposure to computer and internet have been identified and imparted computer knowledge.

The college has a centralized Wi-Fi facility.

29. Financial aid to students:

Our students avail SC-ST scholarship 236 SC students availed a scholarship amount of Rs. 7,62,900 for the academic year 2015-2016. Moreover Abboy Trust offers a financial assistance, every year in the name of Abboy Trust Scholarship to the meritorious students and to the students with poor financial background to the tune of Rs.1, 00, 000.

30. Support from the Alumni Association and its activities:

The alumni meet has been scheduled to be on the first Sunday of every May. The Alumni Meet has been organized on 03 May 2016. The alumni offered lots of suggestions towards the development of the college. They came forward to help and guide their friends who are jobless and who are in the pursuit of higher studies. The alumni who have occupied executive positions in corporate sectors met the students of their discipline and explained them about the scope for jobs and higher studies.

31. Support from the Parent-Teachers Association and its activities:

Parent Teachers Association Meeting was held on 21.10.2015 and 07.04.2016. Their complaints, grievances, ideas and suggestions have been duly recorded and taken into account. Dr. E. Pari, M.B.B.S., a general physician visits the college premises every week and offers medical advice to students.

36. Activities of Guidance and Counseling Cell:

The Guidance and Counseling Cell of our college has been functioning effectively. They monitor the activities of students within the campus, and while they travel in college busses. Students of first, second and third year are met separately and they are given appropriate advice as soon as the college reopens every year. Girl-students have been met at various occasions and they are informed about the code of conduct and dressing. Any mark of lack of discipline on their part is enquired promptly and disciplinary measures have been taken. As it is a rustic area, there are chances of prolonged absentees. Guidance and Counseling Cell takes much responsibility to avoid their discontinuation of their courses. The poor students are rightly advised, encouraged and are given financial assistance too by providing a concession in tuition fees.

37. Placement Services Provided to Students

The Placement Cell of Indo-American College is taken care of by the Placement Officer Mr. P.Varadharajan, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Applications. One teaching staff from each department has been nominated to carryout placement training and activities. The placement coordinators are Mr. D.Panner Selvan, Dr.L.Dinesh, Mr. Rajaganapathy, Mr.Senthil Kumaran, Mr.Pachaiyappan, Mr.Parthiban, and Dr.K.Prabu.

He creates and maintains contacts with companies that could offer placement opportunities for students. He also trains students with employability skills in collaboration with TCS, SPS and other agencies, and arranges for campus interviews both in and off-campus.

FREE EMPLOYABILITY TRAINING PROGRAM BY TCS

Tata Consultancy Services is an international software company which trains students on employability skills and hires proficient students from reputed institutions to work for their companies. The company offers Free Employability Training Program to the students of rural colleges. The Consultant Trainer, Mr.Nayeem Khan of TCS offered training program for the students of Indo American College. One training batch consisted of 50 to 60 students. The duration was three hours a day on all working days. This free employability Training lasted for a total of 100 hours. At the end of the free training, TCS BPS (Business Process Services) Recruitment Team visited Indo American College and conducted the recruitment process. The successful candidates, who cleared the objective entrance test and interviews, were issued TCS BPS Invitation Letters to attend the TCS Initial Learning Program (ILP) after their graduation. On successful completion of the ILP, the candidates would secure TCS BPS entry level jobs with the first year's monthly stipend being Rs.13,000/- to Rs.17,000/-, depending on their work timing.

SPS TRAINING PROGRAM

SPS Training Academy is a Life-Skills Training Company based in Chennai. Their aim is to offer exclusive and customized training program to the students of Indo-American College, Cheyyar at a nominal fare, to enhance their overall personality and to teach them the communication skills they require while learning and during their career. They train students on English, Personality development, Soft skills and Aptitude.

The Academy approached the Principal with the proposal to offer training on the aforementioned areas. They started their classes on 04.07.2016 and the classes went up to 19.09.2016. An addition of one hour in teaching has been extended every day to make up 30 to 40 hours of teaching their modules. The duration of the course is 30 Hours for the first year, 35 hours for the second year and 40 hours for the final year and PG students.

SPS Training Academy organized a Presentation program to offer platform to bring out their presentation/ Speaking Skills. One Hundred and Seventy One students participated in the presentation and presented papers on various topics of interest. Best performers from each class were also highlighted.

To encourage students, SPS gave mementos to all the participants, and trophies were also given to those classes which contributed participants in large numbers.

The programme showed considerable results. Students showed more involvement in studies; volunteered to present papers in seminars; External personality and groom of the students have been enhanced; Behavioral changes are visible; students realized that their stage fright and their inhibitions had been overcome; realized the necessity of dressing well and dressing formally; Felt that their confidence had a lot improved; Realized the importance of etiquette and body language.

FOREBRAIN ONLINE APTITUDE TEST

Forebrain Technologies is a Private Consultancy which hires skilled students from reputed institutions and supplies them to several Multinational Companies around the globe.

The concern offered to conduct an Online Aptitude Test for the students of Indo-American College on 01.09.2016 and 02.09.2016. A total of Five Hundred and forty nine students participated in the Online Aptitude Test held at the three Computer Labs of the Department of Computer science and applications, making use of 75 Computer systems, with the assistance of our teachers Mr. P.Varadarajan, Mr. M.Viswanathan and Mr.C.Parthiban.

OFF CAMPUS INTERVIEW IN ASSOCIATION WITH SURYA INFORMATICS

The Placement Cell of Indo-American College in association with Surya Informatics, IT Company organized an Off-campus Interview at Sacred Heart Evening College, Tirupattur. Seventeen students of the Department of Computer Science and Computer Applications attended the interview.

TATA CONSULTANCY SERVICES (TCS) CAMPUS RECRUITMENT

Tata Consultancy Services offered a training program to the students of our college. The passed out students of May 2016 underwent training and 16 were selected (8 students from Indo-American College & 8 from Sri Akilandeshwari Women's College) for various positions.

The company offered Employability training program for the empowerment of students of rural background. It deputed an experienced trainer Mr. Nayeem Khan, (Trainer, TCS Private Ltd to our college) who trained students and it lasted for a total of 100 hours. The training consisted of interactive exercises designed significantly to improve English communication skills, self confidence, self esteem, aptitude and soft skills among students which are required for recruitment. The students who regularly attended the said training program received TCS participation certificates.

The company offered Employability training program for the empowerment of students of rural background. 38. Development programmes for Non-teaching staff:

Typewriting and Computer Training have been given to the non teaching staff. Meditation and yoga courses have been organized for them. Interested candidates have been taught to drive light vehicles. English is taught to them to make simple conversations.

39. Best practices of the Institution:

- The college adheres to the reservation policy.
- Admission of candidates is based on the merits of the qualifying examination.
- The students have the choice to choose their major and allied subjects.
- Guidance is given to students and parents to choose courses.
- Flexibility of time frame to complete the programme and to change subject specializations.

- Project work is compulsory for all the PG courses.
- Students' performances are assessed through weekly, monthly, unit and model tests.
- PG students have to make presentations in Seminars as a part of course work.
- Weak students and dullards are identified and special coaching is given.
- In addition to the Traditional methods of teaching, audiovisual aids are used.
- Progress reports are sent to parents periodically.
- Transport facility is offered even to the most remote areas.
- Courses are conducted to enhance interpersonal and employability skills.
- Students and teachers engage themselves in extension activities through voluntary organizations like NSS, YRC, CCC, RRC etc.
- Financial assistance to the poor candidates is given.
- Assertive on quality in teaching and learning.
- Staff members are recruited through rigorous interviews.
- Courses on yoga and meditation are offered to students, free of cost, every year.
